 - Go to general settings then scroll down and click on "Activate the developer mode"
 - User Name: admin, Password: admin, Copy database name from top right corner(If not shown then refresh once, inspect code, and copy from there)
 - Note: Please don't click the sync button during the demo instance because if you have thousands of data it will take more than an hour for queue execution.
- Now go into the plugin configuration
- Fill up the username, password(If you have created API key then use that for security), database name and server URL
